Certified Nurse Aides (C.N.A.s) provide quality care to patients in hospitals, nursing homes, and healthcare facilities. Duties include taking vital signs, catheter care, as well as basic range of motion exercises and daily personal hygiene care. The C.N.A. Training Program offered at CMP Academy takes 2-3 months to complete, and the curriculum includes Class Instruction, Lab Training, Clinical Internship and participation in the New York State Certification Exam. After the students receive C.N.A. licenses, they will also get job placement assistance from CMP.
